<p>1.</p> <p>1.1</p> <p>1.2</p> <p>1.3</p>	<p>Introduction</p> <p>Dumfries and Galloway Integration Joint Board (IJB) is committed to the accountability of locality health and social care services to communities through their Area Committees. Every 6 months, localities report their progress towards the National Health and Wellbeing Outcomes.</p> <p>As a result of the Covid 19 pandemic, there is limited staffing capacity to produce and publish the year's full suite of performance reports. Therefore, in accordance with Scottish Government advice relating to reporting during the pandemic to take a pragmatic approach, these reports are compact and some of the standard information has not been available (noted where applicable).</p> <p>The IJB is asked to discuss and approve these reports prior to circulation to Local Authority Area Committees.</p>

This framework requires each locality to report to their respective Area Committee every 6 months.</p> <p>This set of reports provides information up to 31 December 2020 (where possible) on performance against a range of indicators. These indicators relate to the commitments contained within the Integration Joint Board's Strategic Plan for Health and Social Care which, in turn, relate to the 9 national health and wellbeing outcomes.</p>
<p>4.</p> <p>4.1</p>	<p>Conclusions</p> <p>Each locality is working towards delivering the 9 National Health and Wellbeing Outcomes in ways suitable for that locality. The Covid 19 situation has impacted on how services are delivered, however all localities report making progress against the National Outcomes.</p>
