1. Introduction

- 1.1 The Public Bodies (Joint Working) (Scotland) Act 2014 places legislative requirements on Integration Authorities to have a Strategic Commissioning Plan (SCP) in place.
- 1.2 A Final Draft SCP has been developed with involvement from Dumfries and Galloway Integration Joint Board (IJB) members and a wide range of appropriate stakeholders.
- 1.3 This paper seeks IJB approval for the Final Draft SCP.

2. Recommendations

2.1 The Integration Joint Board is asked to approve:

- **The Final Draft Health and Social Care Strategic Commissioning Plan 2022 – 2025 (see Appendix One) for publication on 1 April 2022.**

3. Background and Main Report

- 3.1 The Final Draft SCP has been developed in accordance with legislative requirements and national and local guidance.
- 3.2 Due to the Covid-19 pandemic, work to develop the previous Strategic Commissioning Plan was paused twice. This resulted in an extension to the period of relevance for the SCP 2018 – 2021 to 31 March 2022.
- 3.3 To ensure that the Final Draft SCP accurately reflects the vision, principles and strategic intentions of the IJB, the IJB members have been fully engaged, informed and involved throughout its development.
- 3.4 The Final Draft SCP has been co-created with input from people who use care and support, their families, Carers, members of the public, people who work in Health and Social Care, the Strategic Planning Group (SPG), Third Sector and Independent Sector partners.
- 3.5 A Statement of Consultation on the development of the Final Draft SCP is attached at Appendix Two.
- 3.6 Significant learning has been recorded in the Partnership Consultation Evaluation Report that has been completed and submitted to the Consultation and Engagement Working Group for approval. This learning will be available as a shared resource for colleagues developing projects and strategies in the future (see Appendix Three).

4. Conclusions

- 4.1 The Final Draft SCP meets the legislative requirements of the Public Bodies (Joint Working) (Scotland) Act 2014, for Integration Authorities to have a plan in place.
- 4.2 The Final Draft SCP 2022 – 2025 is a culmination of the knowledge and lived experience that was shared by people who work and access health and social care in Dumfries and Galloway. A record of stakeholder involvement is recorded in the Statement of Consultation that will be published online.

9.3 Equality implications have been considered and an Equalities Impact Assessment (EQIA) was updated throughout the engagement and consultation stages of the development of the SCP.
