#### 1. Minutes of the Previous Meeting

#### 2. Appointment of a Chair for the Strategic Planning Group

AW as the Governance Officer of the IJB reviewed the process of the Recruitment of the Chair for the Strategic Planning Group.

#### 3. Update on the Strategic Commissioning Plan

VF provided an overview of a presentation she completed regarding the Strategic Commissioning Plan for Health and Social Care.

An easy read Consultation Document was shared with colleagues and have had positive feedback. The information was sent to 7,262 people, groups and organisations with 52 representatives in meetings and workshops, VF confirmed there has been over 500 comments made.

Feedback on the engagement regarding Smart Survey Data was shared with colleagues, this highlights how broad the information was that was shared.

Continued conversations are being had between all Partners across the Health and Social Care Partnership. VF will share the Presentation which was presented with colleagues.

GS asked how we link and define "Happy", VF confirmed this is important going forward to help people with the vision and model of care.

JW asked for regular updates to be presented regarding the progress and any issues, VF will link with CB regarding this.

AM will share the presentation with colleagues.

# 4. Reflections on the Independent Review of Adult Social Care

JW highlighted our view of moving away from our Current Model, the focus will be on Carers, wither that be paid or unpaid carers be equal partners. In the near future a meeting will be scheduled to go through this report in more detail and to think of our thoughts and reflections, there is a lot of positive messages and themes.
