1. Introduction

1.1 This Report is provided today to advise Members of a change in the Voting and Advisory Membership of the Integration Joint Board

2. Recommendations

2.1 The Integration Joint Board is asked:

- Note that Ronnie Tate has withdrawn his voting membership of the IJB with effect from October 2021
- Note that we await response from the Local Authority on a replacement Voting Member
- David Rowland in his new role as Director of Strategic Planning and Transformation will become an Advisory Member

3. Background and Main Report

- 3.1 The Public Bodies (Joint Working) (Integration Joint Board) (Scotland) Order 2014 sets out the legislation for Membership of Integration Joint Boards and that there should be an equitable number of Voting Members for each of the constituent authorities around the Integration Joint Board. In the Dumfries and Galloway Integration Scheme the constituent authorities opted for 5 Voting Members each.
- 3.2 In October of this year, Ronnie Tait advised that he would no longer be sitting as a Voting Member of the IJB, and that he has requested that a replacement be found.
- 3.3 At the time of writing this paper we are not yet aware of who will replace Ronnie Tait as Voting Member of the Integration Joint Board.
- The Public Bodies (Joint Working) (Scotland) Act 2014, states that each Integration Authority must have a Strategic Commissioning Plan, as Members are aware this document is currently under review. By appointing the Director of Strategic Planning and Transformation, David Rowland, as an Advisory Member to the IJB this will ensure that the IJB is informed and updated on all aspects of the Strategic Commissioning Plan and on the delivery once it becomes legislative.

4. Conclusions

4.1 Based on the information provided within this report it is anticipated that the IJB will note the changes as outlined within the recommendations in Section 2.
