1. Introduction

1.1 This paper is presented to inform Members of, with effect from the 3rd April 2021, the appointments of Chair and Vice Chair of the Integration Joint Board, to ask Members to appoint to the positions of Chair and Vice Chairs of the IJB Committees and to note the change to the Dumfries and Galloway Council Voting Membership.

3. Background and Main Report

- 3.1 The Public Bodies (Joint Working) (Integration Joint Boards) (Scotland) Order 2014 outlines that a chairperson of the Integration Joint Board is to be appointed by a constituent authority (either Dumfries and Galloway Council or NHS Dumfries and Galloway) for a period not greater than 3 years, in the Dumfries and Galloway Integration Scheme this has been confirmed as 2 years.
- 3.2 As the last appointment to the position of Chair of the IJB was made at the meeting of the 3rd April 2019, when Andy Ferguson was appointed to the position of Chair, the next Chair of the IJB will be an IJB voting member appointed by NHS Dumfries and Galloway who have notified us that the position of Chair of the IJB will be fulfilled by Laura Douglas. The position of Vice Chair has been awarded by the Local Authority members, to Dumfries and Galloway Voting Member of the IJB, Jane Maitland. These appointments will take effect from the 3rd April 2021.
- 3.3 Members are asked to extend their thanks to Andy Ferguson in his role as Chair of the IJB over the last two years, which has been a time of tremendous change for the Board and to welcome both Laura Douglas and Jane Maitland to their new positions.
