1. Introduction

1.1 This paper aims to update the Integration Joint Board (IJB) Clinical and Care Governance Committee on the implementation of the IJB Housing with Care and Support Strategy 2020 – 2023.

2. Recommendations

2.1 The Clinical and Care Governance Committee is asked to:

 Note the progress to date and planned next steps in relation to implementation of the IJB Housing with Care and Support Strategy 2020 – 2023.

3. Background and Main Report

- 3.1 Housing is an important factor in maintaining and sustaining the health and wellbeing of people and reducing health inequalities. This is particularly true for vulnerable people such as older people and people with disabilities.
- 3.2 Housing with care and support is the term used to describe a holistic approach to planning the provision of health and social care and support that meetings people's needs where they live.
- 3.3 The IJB approved their Housing with Care and Support Strategy 2020 2023 in November 2019. This strategy relates to the aspects of housing with care and support that are delegated to the IJB from the NHS and Local Authority. That is personal care and support as well as some aspects of housing support, for example aids and adaptations. Links and references are made throughout the strategy to other relevant local and national plans that relate to the broader functions that alight to housing with care and support but are not delegated to the IJB.
- 3.4 The Health and Social Care Partnership has an established Housing with Care and Support Group with membership from across health and social care partnership and wider stakeholders. Membership is provided in Appendix 1.
- 3.5 Since March 2020 the Health and Social Care Partnership has had to prioritise clinical and support services as part of the covid-19 pandemic response. This means that key personnel involved in the development of the implementation plan for Housing with Care and Support Strategy have been deployed elsewhere and the Housing with Care and Support Group has not met as frequently as it would in normal circumstances.
- 3.6 Therefore, there has been limited progress in delivering the ambitions within the strategy. There have also been significant changes across the whole health and social care system that require a fresh perspective on the implementation plan.

3.7 The following table provides an update on housing with care and support projects currently in development.

Next Steps

- The Housing with Care and Support Group has been re-established and will report to the newly established Community Transformation Programme Board. This will ensure that their work is linked with other major pieces of work within the Partnership, such as the review of community beds and home team's implementation.
- 3.9 The Community Health and Social Care Directorate have been restructured recently and the Locality Manager for Annandale and Eskdale now has a specific region wide remit in relation to residential care, including housing with care and support. This Locality Manager chairs the Housing with Care and Support Group and will bring a region wide perspective to developments across all four localities.
- 3.10 The Housing with Care and Support Group will, over the next three months, finalise the strategy implementation plan, taking account of the changes felt as a result of the pandemic. Consideration will also be given as to whether there is a need to refresh the strategy as it now enters the last year of its relevant period and the next Strategic Commissioning Plan will be published in April 2022.
- 3.11 The newly established Strategic Planning and Transformation Directorate, and Strategic Planning Commissioning, Sustainability comprising Modernisation and Performance and Intelligence Teams provides an opportunity for the Housing with Care and Support Group to access resources and expertise to support implementation of the Plan. When fully developed the Housing with Care and Support Implementation Plan will be included as part of the new Partnership Delivery Plan which pulls together all the partnership activities to ensure delivery of the Strategic Commissioning Plan, RMP4 and the Sustainability and Modernisation pipeline. This joined up approach will enable consistency and ease of data collection, reporting and evaluation.
