1. Introduction

1.1 Following discussion at the Transformation and Innovation/Futures Committee on 10th November 2022, a vote was held and the paper approved for the IJB's consideration and direction for NHS Dumfries and Galloway (NHS D&G) to undertake an independently chaired local service review of maternity services in the Wigtownshire locality, this will be inclusive of an options appraisal.

2. Recommendations

2.1 The Integration Joint Board is asked to:

• To consider this paper and issue a direction to NHS D&G to undertake the review

3. Background and Main Report

- 3.1 Following the temporary suspension of intrapartum maternity services in the west of the region in 2018 due to staffing pressures, a review of services for expectant mothers is sought. This was discussed previously at the IJB Transformation and Innovation/Futures Committee on 10th November 2022.
- 3.2 Brief background and history of this temporary suspension is detailed in Appendix 1.

4. Conclusions

- 4.1 Independent chairs have been sought to ensure transparency and initial briefings have been progressed. The draft terms of reference are currently being collaborated on and will be made available in due course.
- 4.2 Additional external professional expertise will be sought as part of the stakeholder and consultation and engagement process.
- 4.3 A programme for consultation and engagement will be developed in conjunction with the Consultation and Engagement Working Group, which additionally has external representation. An identified communications lead will be available throughout the review period.

5. Resource Implications

5.1 The approval to proceed with an options appraisal will be inclusive of an impact assessment considering financial, workforce and accessibility standards.
