#### 1. Introduction

1.1 The purpose of this report is to inform the IJB of the new Members following the changes in Administration at the Local Authority and Revised Membership of Outside Bodies.

Following the Full Council meeting on the 07.03.2023, and discussions between the political groups represented in the Full Council, the following Elected Members have been appointed to the IJB:

- 3.2 Local authority members will be asked to appoint the Chair of the IJB from their voting membership. The position of Chair will terminate on the 1st April 2023, when Local Authority members will appoint the Chair of the IJB. These changes are made every 2 years as outlined in the Public Bodies (Integration Joint Board) (Scotland) Order 2014 and the Dumfries and Galloway Integration Scheme.
- 3.3 The Revised Scheme of Delegation has commenced where the first meetings of the newly established committees have taken place together with sign off of the new Terms of Reference at Committee level, however committee membership will have to be updated following changes to Membership.
- 3.4 All new Members should be aware that it is their duty to notify the Business Support Team if they are unable to attend any meeting. committee or workshop relating to their role as an IJB Member.
- 3.5 If a member has not attended three consecutive meetings of the IJB, and their absence was not due to illness or other reasonable cause, the IJB may remove the

	member from office by providing the member with one month's notice in writing (The Public Bodies (Joint Working) (Integration Joint Board) (Scotland) Order 2014.						
3.6	All new members will be provided with the opportunity to undertake induction to the IJB with a series of development sessions also planned throughout the year.
