7. IJB FINANCIAL PLAN AND BUDGET FOR 2023/24

KK confirmed this report outlines the revenue budget for Dumfries and Galloway Integration Joint Board for 2023/24 and the budget available for services commissioned from NHS Dumfries and Galloway and Dumfries and Galloway Council.

This paper was considered at the IJB Finance, Performance and Quality Committee on the 13th April and also discussed via the Health and Social Care Leadership Group on 20th April.

Due to the underlying deficit on the NHS Delegated Budget it is not presented as a balanced budget, this is the first year since Integration we have been in this position.

KK provided an overview of Table 1, highlighting the significant pressures. All funding received by Partners in relation to health and social care has been fully passed on to the IJB and the CO and CFO have had a number of positive conversations with NHS and Local Authority colleagues in terms of budgets, this has been a positive relationship. KK highlighted the engagement of operational leads and professional leads in setting the savings plans set out in Appendix 1.

We continue to see inflationary pressures across the Board, the pressures are outstripping the available new monies, which is continuing to be a risk.

The IJB Finance, Performance and Quality Committee will monitor the savings throughout the year. The yearend position has not yet been confirmed for last year but will be reported via the next IJB Board.

- Noted that the IJB's Performance, Finance and Quality Committee reviewed the draft Financial Plan at its meeting on 13th April 2023 and supported submission of the final draft to the IJB for approval.
- Acknowledged the recurring deficit position of the NHS Delegated budget and the ongoing discussions between the NHS Board and Scottish Government.
- Noted the financial estimates and savings plan as set out in the draft Plan.
- Approved the Financial Plan for the 2023/24 as set out in this report.
- Supported the development of the savings proposals as set out in Appendix 1 to the paper and direct the Dumfries and Galloway NHS Board and Dumfries and Galloway Council to develop the savings proposals to support the delivery of the Financial Plan.
- Proposed that all savings proposals are supported subject to more detailed development and will require being impact assessed with reporting back on outcome required.
- Noted that reporting on delivery of the detailed Financial Plan will be undertaken through the IJB's Performance, Finance and Quality Committee.
- Approved the delegation of a budget of £365.044m to NHS Dumfries and Galloway and direct that this budget is spent in line with the Strategic Plan of the IJB and the proposals as set out in Appendix 1.
- Approved the delegation of a budget of £107.191m to Dumfries and Galloway Council and direct that this budget is spent in line with the Strategic Plan of the IJB and the proposals as set out in Appendix 1.

8. INTEGRATION JOINT BOARD FINANCIAL ANALYSIS 2021 / 2022

This report provides IJB members with a copy of the Audit Scotland Report which is here today just for noting. The Integration Joint Boards: Financial Analysis 2021/22 which was published in April 2023. The scales of the challenges and risks are included in the report.

The need for Transformational Change is highlighted within the report and gives an idea of the position across the IJBs.

9. MATERNITY SERVICES UPDATE

DR confirmed following discussion at the Integration Joint Board on 8th December 2022, a direction was issued for NHS Dumfries and Galloway to undertake an independently chaired local service review of maternity services in the Wigtownshire locality; this will be inclusive of an options appraisal.

The engagement period for the Maternity Services review concluded at end March 2023. The purpose of the engagement period was to seek views of the public and stakeholders whilst informing and developing potential options for the future provision of Maternity services in Wigtownshire.

This paper details the next steps for the review, including the options appraisal exercise, consultation period and revised timeline. AMcF asked for comments regarding the Independent Chairs stepping down, JW mentioned once the preferred option is provided it is understandable that the Chairs will wish to step down, but a conversation can be had operationally should we require to re engaging them later in the process.

MK suggested given the Independent hairs and expert will be stepping down once the preferred option is identified, it would be beneficial for the Independent Team to attend an IJB prior to this to highlight the process. DR will pick up a conversation with the Commissioning Team regarding this approach.
