<b>3.</b>	<b>Background and Main Report</b>
3.1	Following Integration Joint Board (IJB) approval of the Right Care Right Place: Bed Based Intermediate Care report on 27 September 2023 ten directions have been issued to Dumfries and Galloway Council and NHS Dumfries and Galloway. This includes a direction to commission 31 care home beds across the eight home team areas before end of March 2024.
3.2	In line with due process and EQIA has been completed, Appendix 1. No negative impacts and 15 areas of positive impact have been identified.
3.3	The EQIA will be published on Council and NHS websites.
