Appendix 7 – Options Appraisal Process

There are five critical success factors set out by Scottish Government:

- Economic Efficiency: the cost-effectiveness of options.
- Effectiveness: how well options achieve objectives.
- Risk and Uncertainty: potential risks and uncertainties.
- **Distributional Impacts**: the impact on different groups.
- Social and Environmental Impact: broader societal effects.

These critical success factors will be used to shortlist options, with involvement of key stakeholders including the focused workshop participants, a range of professionals, such as GPs, nurses, physiotherapists and occupational therapists who are involved in the delivery of care in local areas.
