It relates specifically to a range of aspects set out by the National Mission on drugs, to report on progress in these areas.</p>

Health and social care services contribute to reducing health inequalities</p> <p>Outcome 7. People who use health and social care services are safe from harm.</p> <p>This paper has not previously been discussed at the IJB or one of its committees</p> <p>The National Mission was launched to reduce drug-related deaths/harms and improve lives impacted by drugs. A wide range of initiatives falls under the umbrella of the National Mission including</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Fast access to treatment and support services</li> <li>• Increased capacity in the use of residential rehabilitation</li> <li>• Standards to improve Medication-Assisted Treatment (MAT)</li> <li>• Including people with lived/living experience and family members in decision making and service provision</li> <li>• Supporting children and families affected by problematic drug use</li> <li>• Emergency life saving interventions- naloxone, assertive outreach, safer consumption</li> </ul> <p>The ADP three year strategy and delivery plan 2023-2026 is currently into its second year with a wide range of actions already completed to address the areas highlighted in the National Mission.</p> <p>The Annual Reporting Survey data provides information on progress of the National Mission at a local level and supports the work of the national organisations which support local delivery.</p>
<p>4.</p> <p>4.1</p> <p>4.2</p>	<p><b>Conclusions</b></p> <p>The ADP Annual Reporting Survey shows the wide range of work already underway, which supports the National Mission and also the national and local alcohol and drugs strategies.</p> <p>There has been increased engagement with people in recovery and also those with lived/living experience and family members to ensure their voices are heard and they are able to be involved in service planning, delivery and decision making.</p>
